Format and Font. Manuscripts must be DIN-A4 pages, double-spaced, left justified (*Word format*) with 2.5 cm <u>margins</u> on all sides. Font size: 12 (Times New Roman).

1. Cover Page

- 1. Title
- 2. Authors
- 3. Filiations
- 4. Running title
- 5. Corresponding author(s) name and contact address

2. Text, with the following structure:

- 1. Summary with key words (up to 6)
- 2. Introduction
- 3. Materials and Methods
- 4. Results
- 5. Discussion
- 6. Acknowledgements
- 7. References. The cited journal articles preferently must only be from journals that use a peer-review system.
- *. In case of a short report. Material, Methods and Results should integrated and named: Case Report. And discussion should be named: Comments.

3. Figures

"If the authors fail to present good quality images the study is not in a position to be published in *EJA*". Advices for get images acceptable for publication:

- 1. Look for better fields of the sample. They could be plenty of artifacts (broken tissue, free epithelium, etc.)
- 2. Improve image acquisition: the focus on, bright and contrast.
- 3. The digital quality must be improving. JPEG / TIFF format with a minimum resolution of 300 DPI.
- 4. No figures should be included within the text file or document.
- 5. Figures should be presented in separate files or documents.
- 6. Legends for figures will be submitted in a separate document named: Legends for figures

4. Tables and Graphics

- 1. No tables or graphics should be included within the text file or document.
- 2. Tables and graphics should be presented in separate files or documents.
- 3. Tables and graphics should be submitted in word format.
- 4. Legends for tables and graphics will be submitted in separate documents named: Legends for tables and graphics
